# Your Personal Brand Is a Pattern

# Profile and Portfolio Audit

- My name, photo and headline are clear and consistent.
- My bio explains who I am, what I do and who my content or work is for.
- My profile includes a useful next step: portfolio, contact, shop, booking or featured work.
- My strongest work is easy to find without scrolling through unrelated posts.
- I removed outdated claims, broken links and contact details I no longer use.
- I checked spelling, tone, image quality and mobile readability.
- My content shows evidence, process or useful insight rather than only self-promotion.
- I understand which personal details should remain private.

# One-Day Content Production Plan

Stage	Time	Checklist
Plan	30 min	Choose one audience problem, one message, three formats and a clear call to action.
Prepare	30 min	Confirm location, lighting, wardrobe or props, battery, storage, privacy and permissions.
Create	60-120 min	Capture the essential version first, then optional variations.
Organize	20 min	Rename files, back up originals and record usage rights or collaboration notes.
Edit	60 min	Improve clarity and pacing without changing the truth of the result.
Review	15 min	Check claims, spelling, safety, accessibility and whether the post helps the audience.

## Professional and Personal Safety

- I separate public business contact details from private personal accounts.
- I do not publish home address, daily route, private documents or live location without a strong reason.
- For collaborations, I confirm deliverables, payment, usage rights, deadlines and cancellation terms in writing.
- I understand where and how my photos, video or work may be used before giving permission.
- I use unique passwords or passkeys and enable multi-factor authentication.
- I keep original files and records of agreements.
- I do not let urgency or flattery pressure me into unsafe meetings, payments or content.
- I have a trusted contact, check-in plan or public meeting location when appropriate.

Day	Action	Done
Day 1	Write three pieces of evidence that you can learn, adapt or finish difficult things.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Day 2	Improve one small visible detail: profile, workspace, document or outfit preparation.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Day 3	Practice one skill for 20 minutes without posting or comparing.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Day 4	Send one clear message, application, pitch or request.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Day 5	Do one task you have delayed because it felt imperfect.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Day 6	Review feedback and choose one useful improvement, not every opinion.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Day 7	Publish, submit or share one honest piece of work.	<input type="checkbox"/>
